Scouting

Troop 233 embraces the concept of a Scout lead Troop. Youth Leadership conducts all meetings, plans and manages monthly camping trips, and assists with teaching skills and merit badges. Adult leadership assists and guides the scouts in making decisions that are good for the Troop.



Camping

Since 3/4 of Scouting is "outing", Troop 233 offers many opportunities for camping, hiking, and other outdoor activities. We hold monthly weekend camping, as well as single day activities such as hikes or service projects. There are also opportunities for scouts to participate in the yearly Summer camp (6-7 days), and Winter camp (4-5 days). For older scouts (14 +), we offer High Adventure camping trips.



Dues

Troop 233 aims to make its program affordable for all youth. Our annual Christmas Tree recycling fundraiser allows us to keep our fees at \$100 plus current BSA registration fees. This covers all costs associated with monthly weekend camping trips with the exception of meals. Meals are planned, bought, and prepared by each scout patrol. The troop fee covers one annual troop Class B T-shirt, and all costs associated with badges and rank advancement. The troop supplies tents, stoves, and other troop and patrol gear required for camping. Summer and Winter camps are a separate fee.
